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SANLORENZO GOES TO GREAT LENGTHS...

► She may be the largest Sanlorenzo yacht to date but the sleek lines of the Italian yard's new 64m deftly disguise her 1,500 gross tonnes. Just sold, the yacht is under construction at the yard's new big-boat facility in La Spezia and slated for delivery in 2019. Exterior styling is by Officina Italiana Design and the boat will feature six or seven guest cabins, although no interior designer has been confirmed. sanlorenzoyacht.com

Red hot

What do LaFerrari, the limited-edition supercar, and Mondomarine's new 50m stunner have in common?

WHAT *Ipanema*, just launched by Mondomarine. The sizzling red 49.2m is the first M50 design penned for the Savona yard by the cool, young Milan-based studio Hot Lab. She was built for a Middle Eastern owner who wanted a 6.8m tender rather than a sunbathing spot. So they moved the port garage back to where the beach club would have been, and added two extra cabins.



WHO Hot Lab's three founding partners – Antonio Romano, Michele Dragoni and Enrico Lumini – gave this yacht what Romano describes as an “aggressive” exterior style and a traditional interior. “It is a classical, rich style with more than eight different kinds of marble,” he says. It took them out of their contemporary comfort zone but they are justifiably proud of the result.

WHY The colour? “The owner is passionate about Ferrari cars and he owns a LaFerrari,” says Romano of the limited-edition car, built for just 499 clients. “He asked us to take inspiration from LaFerrari for that particular red.” Hot Lab paired it with black and white to emphasise the sporty lines. hotlab.it; mondomarine.mc
