## SUPERLEGGERA 80

Italian design studio Hot Lab has recently unveiled further details of its innovative concept Superleggera 80, part of Oceanco's Simply Custom line. This 80-meter superyacht represents a perfect fusion of Italian elegance and cutting-edge Dutch engineering.


Superleggera 80 stands out for its clean, essential lines, inspired by the 1960s automotive design. Antonio Romano, Commercial Director of the Viken Group and Hot Lab co-founder, emphasizes the importance of emotions in design: "A worthy design must evoke emotions; otherwise, we would all be creating incredibly optimized and completely sterile boats."

The concept, developed on Oceanco's invitation, is part of a 17-project

Enrico Lumini, Hot Lab Chief Designer, describes Superleggera. 80 as an expression of minimalism and fluidity: "We wanted the design to be soft and minimal, subtly linked to sailing style, without sharp edges and with great continuity of surfaces."

The interiors of Superleggera 80 feature a contemporary and luminous style, with curved furniture,

integrated lighting, wooden finishes and glossy lacquers. A distinctive element is the pool on the aft deck, whose glass far ends elegantly blend with the teak waterfall flowing towards the sea.

The yacht offers accommodations for 12 guests in six cabins, plus a large owner's suite. The spacious common areas include a five-meter-high main atrium, a central bar illuminated by a skylight, an aft beach club and its gym equipped with an opening balcony.

Hot Lab has applied its 'Architecture for Voyagers' concept to the new Superleggera 80, striving to balance style and practicality. "Practicality is emotional," explains Lumini, "it is the feeling that confirms the owners, every time they experience it, that they made the right choice."

Superleggera 80 represents not only an evolution in superyacht design but also a testament to Hot Lab's innovative approach to creating vessels, the one that raises emotions. As Romano concludes: "If our design does not evoke emotions, then we are not designers. Superleggera aims to make you smile. You should admire it and smile inwardly, as if to say: 'Here we go, I've found it, this will be my boat."

This concept promises to redefine the standards of nautical luxury, combining Italian elegance with Dutch engineering in a package that will surely attract the attention of the most discerning owners.
